City Government (Ailina): Proclamation for Conference Complete and ready for pick up Working with A&C committee to print agenda items by next week Housing Project that came up, building in Salt Lake (unsure if for rental or housing) can be found on DPP website for 190 units if rental. Would be for folks who are earning 30-60% AMI. HL question – disability bus pass challenges. HHHRC has had about 2 dozen rejected for reasons (wrong pen color, LSW cannot sign, inadequate reasons etc.) Disconnect on the ground level of staff.
