Topic	Discussion	Outcome/Action
Eligible project types	Jen explained opportunity for ~ \$600,000 for bonus DV project (based on 2018 ppn of 5.8 million). Funds can be used for any one of each: RR, joint TH/PH/RR, SSO-CES, depending on community preference and need, but not PSH. Can also be used to expand existing renewal project, not traditionally focused on DV (though this population can also be served under planned bonus targeting chronic homeless with co-existing mental health and/or substance abuse issues and/or seniors w/ trimorbidity).	
Discussion	Robert okay with either approach. Suzanne asked about locating project at an existing shelter site (partnership). Darlene raised problems with intensive mental health supports to be provided under TH. Marcil/Darlene raised problem of non-experienced providers tapping funds; Jen noted importance of project review process.	Jen to provide additional info on joint project requirements by 7-11-18.
SSO-CES	Jen clarified that current funds were limited to Oahu. At the same time, funds could be used to strengthen Oahu CES with intent to expand to neighbor islands, possibly with future state (legislative) support.	
Vouchers	Robert asked about RR with on-site case management. Jen noted duration issues, given need for long(er)-term services.	Jen reiterated community's interest in (at this time) all possible types of projects. Providers will continue to discuss to narrow focus.
