Do we want to go in and advocate for this? Q: What is our strategy? should	Yes: ask for \$2M for ongoing subsidies, and to have HF put into base budget. • Suggest: support SD1, and
	we throw our weight behind the Senate budget—support WAM Chair, rather than asking her for additional monies as she goes into difficult conference?	 Suggest: support SD1, and also talk to legislators and raise these points: possible to add \$2 M to RRH, or increase RHRF from \$25M? Support the Senate budget with an impact statement modeled on Scott M's. Meet with Chairs re RRH. Betty Lou and Natalie will make appointments. Rep Morikawa's support for \$2m extra RRH is critical. Double check re the number of people to be served = 117= current live people in HF. Jay thought the count was wrong. Who will do the impact statement for SD budget? To be done within next few days. Send to 2 \$ chairs and committee chairs. Greg will do Outreach/Hmsl services; Jay will help. BL to do Affordable housing creation.
