2. Minutes of May meeting	Clarification – AUW contracted to a report on people homeless or at risk of homeless – foster youth, interaction with homeless and at risk. Report in progress. Not yet released. d. user family ---user friendly	Approved with corrections

Natalie: working on visuals, subject is: not appropriation for rental housing revolving fund; because HHFDC has \$135M in the bank not spent. Over the interim we want to prepare something that explains why that money can't be spent b/c already been awarded. Projects need to meet criteria. Development process takes a long time. Developers need to have commitments of funds they need. They get commitment from HHFDC start EIS process which can take 3 years. Permits from gov agencies. This may be an excuse b/c some legislators know this. Can this pipeline be shortened? Need</p>
